

Dzala General Contractor Outlines Step-by-Step Kitchen Remodeling Process for Northern Virginia Homeowners

TYSONS, VA – September 22, 2026 – Dzala General Contractor, a licensed and insured General Contractor based in Tysons, Virginia, has outlined the step-by-step process it follows on residential kitchen projects, giving homeowners in Northern Virginia and Maryland a clearer view of how a remodel moves from first consultation to final walk-through.

The outline follows the company's recent expansion as a kitchen remodeling contractor across the region and centers on the order in which decisions are made. According to the company, a kitchen remodel typically affects structure, plumbing, electrical, ventilation, cabinetry, stone and tile at the same time, which makes the planning sequence as important as the finishes themselves.

Under this approach, each Kitchen Remodeling project begins with a free in-home consultation in which the space is measured and documented. Homeowners then review a design and 3D visualization of the room and approve it before any materials are ordered. Selections for cabinetry, countertops and tile are guided in a set order so that choices are not made all at once or under time pressure. An itemized written quote establishes a fixed scope and line-by-line price before work starts, and any later changes are priced in writing along with their effect on the schedule.

Permits and inspections are filed and tracked by the company in Fairfax County, Arlington County and Montgomery County, Maryland. Once construction begins, work areas are sealed for dust control and cleaned daily, while framing, plumbing, electrical and HVAC work is completed before finishes are installed. The company states that a single in-house crew handles construction from start to finish rather than rotating subcontractors, with one project manager providing dated schedule updates at each stage.

Most kitchen remodels in Northern Virginia are completed in four to eight weeks, according to the company. Factors that can extend a project include county permit review times, cabinetry lead times that begin once selections are final, stone countertop templating that can only start after cabinets are installed, and structural or mechanical conditions discovered once walls are opened. To limit disruption, a temporary kitchen is set up before demolition, and the work is sequenced so the room returns to use before final details are finished.

Material options include custom and semi-custom cabinetry lines, quartz, granite and marble countertops, porcelain, ceramic and natural stone tile, and Benjamin Moore paint. Each project closes with a final walk-through, resolution of punch-list items and handover of warranty documentation.
