ASHBURN, VA — September 3, 2026 — GBC Kitchen and Bath Remodeling Ashburn, a home renovation company based in Ashburn, Virginia, today announced an expansion of its basement remodeling services, adding new finished-space options for homeowners throughout Northern Virginia, Maryland, and Washington, D.C.

The expanded basement remodeling line covers a wider range of finished-space configurations, including entertainment and media rooms, home offices and study spaces, guest suites and bedroom additions, wet bars and kitchenettes, home gyms, and additional bathrooms. The company's project team manages each basement project from waterproofing and framing through electrical, plumbing, and finishing work, with the goal of meeting local building codes while turning underused space into functional living area.

According to the company, basement projects follow the same four-stage process used across its kitchen remodeling and bathroom remodeling services: an initial consultation to review the space and budget, a design and planning phase, project execution by GBC's own installation team, and a final walkthrough before the project is considered complete. The company positions this structure as an extension of the integrated project management system it also applies to kitchen remodeling projects, in which a team is responsible for design, materials, and installation rather than dividing the work among separate subcontractors.

Basement remodeling projects can also include custom built-in storage, egress window installation, new flooring, and laundry relocation, allowing homeowners to combine several updates within a single basement project rather than scheduling them separately. GBC Kitchen and Bath notes that basement finishing has become a way for homeowners to add livable square footage without the cost or disruption of a home addition, particularly in markets where lot sizes limit outdoor expansion.

Egress window installation is included as part of the expanded service line for basements where a bedroom or guest suite is planned, since local building codes generally require a secondary means of exit and natural light for any space used as a sleeping area. The company's team evaluates window placement and structural requirements as part of the design phase, alongside standard waterproofing and moisture-control work intended to keep finished basements comfortable and dry.

GBC Kitchen and Bath Remodeling Ashburn operates showrooms in Ashburn, Alexandria, and Rockville, where homeowners can view cabinetry, countertop, and flooring materials that can also be applied to basement projects such as wet bars or bathroom additions. The company has served homeowners across Northern Virginia, Maryland, and Washington, D.C. since 2001, and states that it has completed projects for more than 6,000 customers across the region.

The company serves communities throughout Fairfax County, Loudoun County, Arlington County, Prince William County, Montgomery County, Howard County, and Washington, D.C., including Ashburn, Leesburg, Sterling, Alexandria, Arlington, Rockville, and Columbia.
